# Sponsorship & Registration

## The Power of Co-Sponsoring

I would like for you all to pray about the **POWER OF CO-SPONSORING**. We have struggled to meet the minimum number of pilgrims so teaming may begin. The minimum for each walk is 20 men and 20 women. These numbers must be met before teaming begins – which is 60 days before the walk. Translation: we must be praying and inviting people MONTHS before the deadline to meet that commitment.

Sponsoring someone takes purposeful pray – money – time and dedication. Last month, I talked about the pray part of sponsoring. This month, I want to talk about the money part. You don't have to go it alone. The power of co-sponsoring someone is tremendous way to further God's kingdom. We all play a part in the body of Christ. Why not consider being the financial part of a pilgrim's weekend, even though you may not know them or to help others bring people closer to Christ.

Where can you find someone to help co-sponsor?

1. In your Reunion group – everyone put in \$50 to help
2. Seek out Butterflies who just flew Chrysalis whose parents haven't walked yet and may have expressed an interest in going.
3. Listen: at Gatherings you may over hear a need, be prepared to step up and help

The deadline to have a full walk is coming up this month for the men, it's March 25<sup>th</sup> and for the women it's April 8<sup>th</sup>. A full walk consists of 36 pilgrims. We are currently at 28 confirmed men and 27 confirmed women, so get the applications in as soon as possible before the walk is FULL!
