It is time for the Tidewater Emmaus Community to pray. Or better yet, PRAY!

There are lots of things to pray for. Those in our community who have trials they are going through, whether we know of them or not. For our churches, pray that they continue to be places that encourage the study of Christ and His blessings. Pray for our families and friends, as they face the slings and arrows of this world.

We should be praying for the teams that have been selected to conduct the fall walks. Let each person understand the service they have been called to perform. Even if they are not exactly where they feel comfortable, let them know that the Holy Spirit selected them and is with them, every step of the way. As the teaming process continues, pray that the fellowship that develops allows each teamer to grow in Christ.

Pray for the pilgrims who have been selected to go on these walks (yes, there will be both men's and women's walks this fall), and those who will be selected. They are where God has placed them. Pray that God opens their hearts and minds and ears to the incredible power of His love. Allow them to be at peace and open to the ministering of the weekend. Pray that the families of the pilgrims are protected throughout the weekend.

Lift up Hope Haven and the staff that will support the upcoming weekends. As this new endeavor unfolds, let the grounds be holy, used to glorify Christ. Pray for the Community Support Team that will work to make the weekend unfold as anonymous servants. Pray that the cloistered environment provides the peace that is required.

When you are finished praying consider the following:

- The Bill Baker Fund was established to provide financial

assistance for all who are interested in sponsoring a pilgrim. Over time it has also been used to assist people who would like to team, but could not afford to. This year, the board adjusted the use of the fund to provide a portion of the funds necessary to sponsor or team (\$100). The application to request those funds is now on the website.

- I am glad that we will conduct Gatherings in three churches that we did not visit last year (plus the one at Hope Haven). If you have a desire to have a different church host next year, please contact Greg Reinhart (Director of Gatherings) and let him know. Those dates get filled quickly.

- Men step it up. There is plenty of room for pilgrims on the men's fall walk. Sponsorship will accept pilgrims for just a couple more weeks. Talk to family and friends and discern if someone you know is ready to go on the Emmaus walk.

Finally, for the fall walks, please remember the importance of maintaining a cloistered environment for the pilgrims. It will be very easy to "visit" at Hope Haven, just to "lend a hand". We need to remember that this will be the pilgrim's weekend and that we need to give them their space. We also have to give space to the team and CST. Other than drop-off, candlelight and closing, please do not visit Hope Haven during the Emmaus weekends.

# APPLICATIONS

The board takes seriously its responsibility to be the instrument of the Holy Spirit in selecting the pilgrims and teams for Emmaus walks. The following directions address how the board gives consideration for those applying to sponsor or team.

1. No application will be considered, during the teamselection process, without the appropriate registration fee(s) or acceptable alternative. This includes sponsor/pilgrim applications.

- Acceptable alternative is normally the use of the Bill Baker Fund to cover some portion of the registration fee or it may also be appropriate that an alternative could be a payment plan clearly delineated and approved by the Directors of Team Selection and Finance.

2. The responsibility of applying for Bill Baker assistance is solely on the sponsor/teamer requiring the assistance. Use of this fund must be done in a timely manner, meeting the set time limits of the team selection process.

- Likewise, if a payment plan is agreed to, it is the responsibility of the sponsor/teamer to meet that plan or to immediately bring to the attention of the board when they cannot.

3. The Directors of Team Selection and Finance will use grace and understanding in every circumstance. However, they are not responsible for any individual applicant not meeting these requirements.

Applications are available at [tidewateremmaus.org](http://tidewateremmaus.org) including the Bill Baker Fund application. Use of the Bill Baker Fund is limited to availability and one time use of \$100 unless repaid.
